



Privacy Policy

Personal Information Collection and Usage

Usage Data

When you visit Kybernan Legal Solutions, we may automatically collect certain usage data. Usage data may include your device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. Personal Information

We may also use this information to contact you with news and special offers regarding additional services that may be relevant to your organization. This information may also be used to attend and manage to any requests that you submit.

reCAPTCHA

We use the reCAPTCHA service provided by Google Inc. (Google) to protect your submissions via Internet submission forms on this site. This plugin checks if you are a person to prevent certain website functions from being used by spam bots (particularly comments). This plugin query includes the sending of the IP address and possibly other data required by Google for the Google reCAPTCHA service. For this purpose, your input will be communicated and used by Google. On behalf of the operator of this website, Google will use this information to evaluate your use of this site.
